The Town's Growth Management Strategy (GMS)



- Intended to define growth and investment over the next 20+ years.
- The G.M.S. will be undertaken along with other studies including the Development Charges Study, Water Environmental Assessment (E.A.) and the Wastewater E.A.
- Together, these studies will provide the Town of Erin Council with guidance on the appropriate timing, phasing, servicing, location and financing of growth between the two villages.

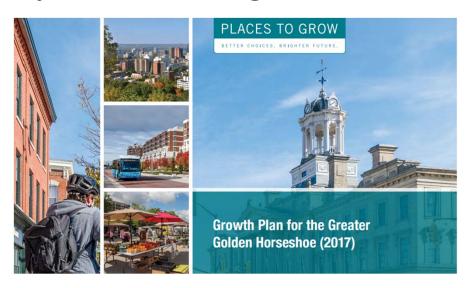
Provincial Planning Policy Context

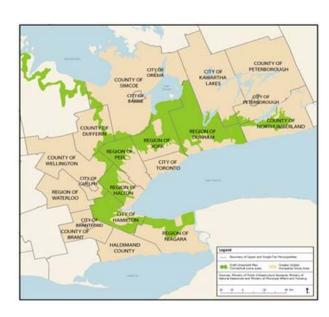

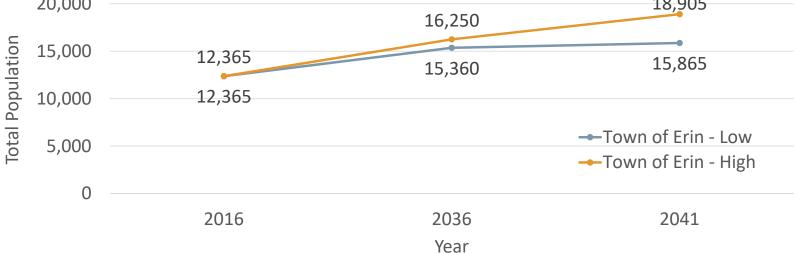

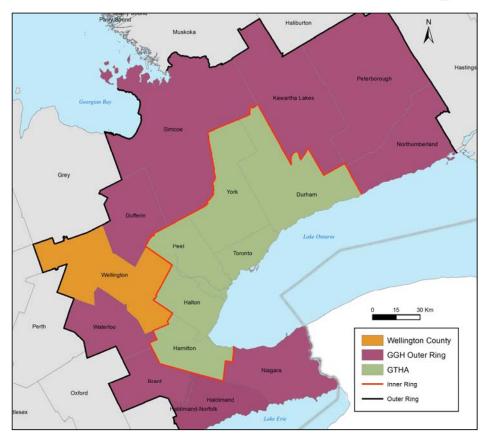

Annual Population Growth Rates within the G.G.H., 2016-2041



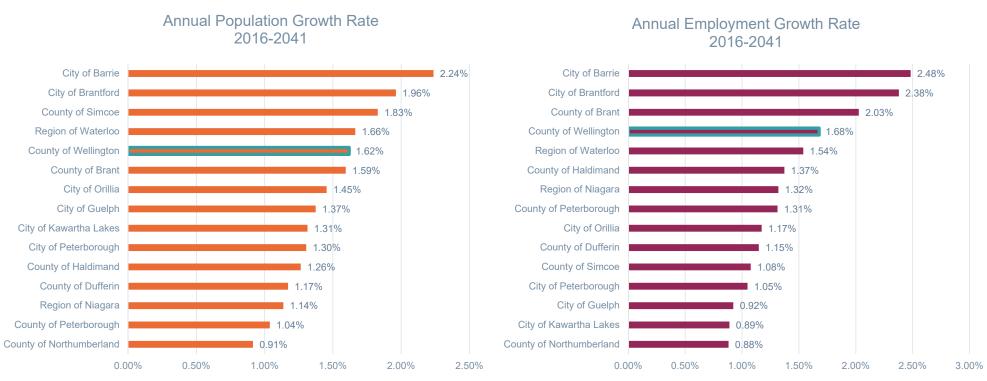

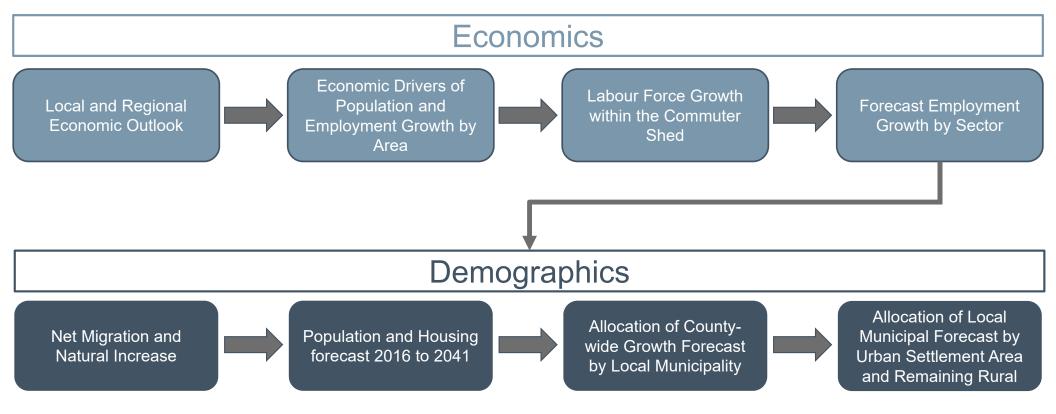
GGH Outer Ring Growth Rate by Municipality, 2016-2041



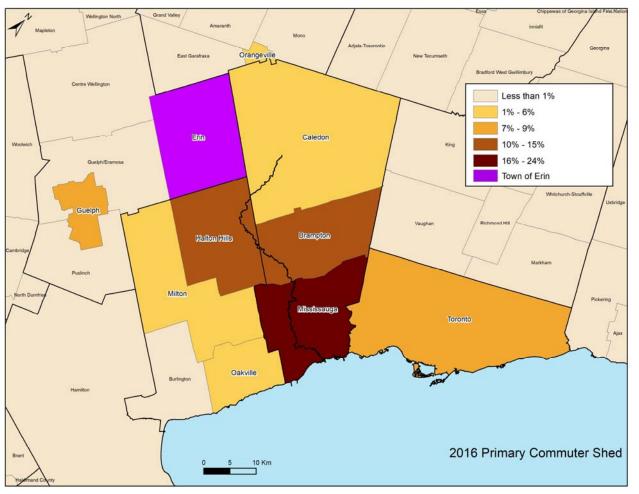

Town of Erin – Primary Commuter Shed





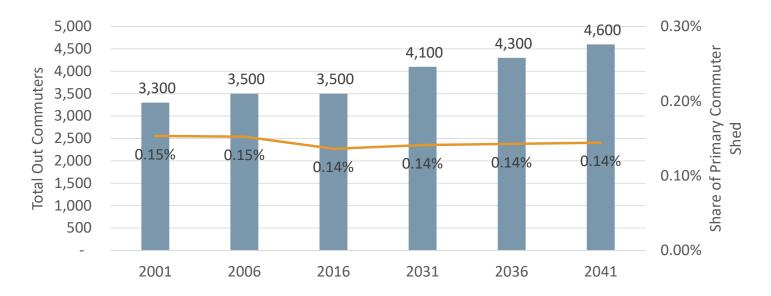


- Commuter Shed jobs from 2016-2041.

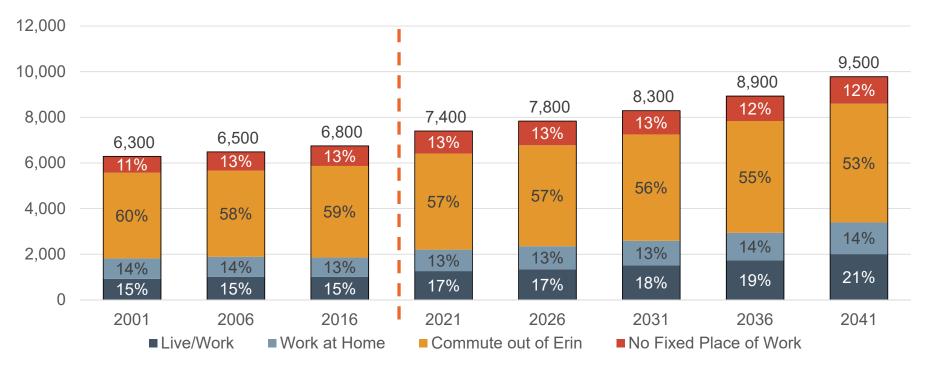

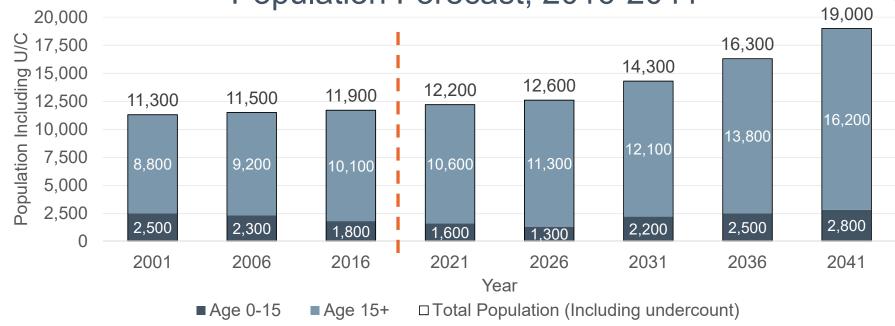
Town of Erin – Employed Labour Force by Sector 2001-2041

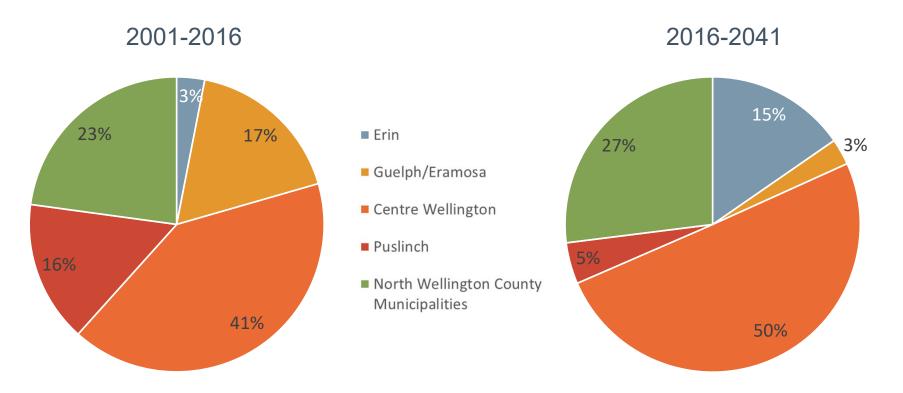

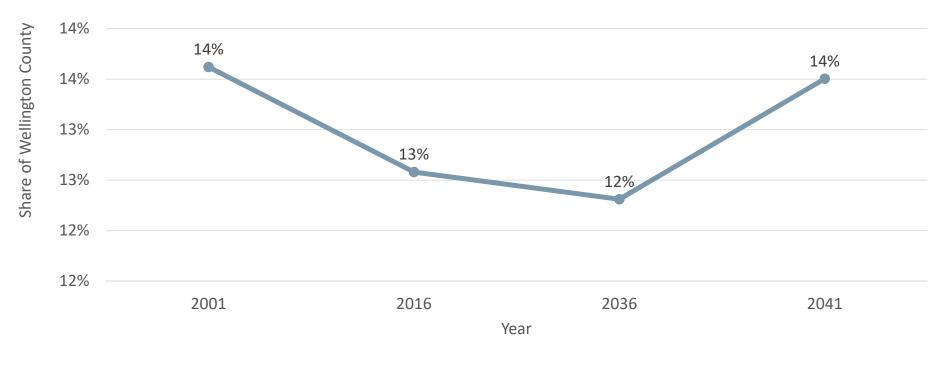

Town of Erin– Share of Wellington County Population, 2001 to 2041



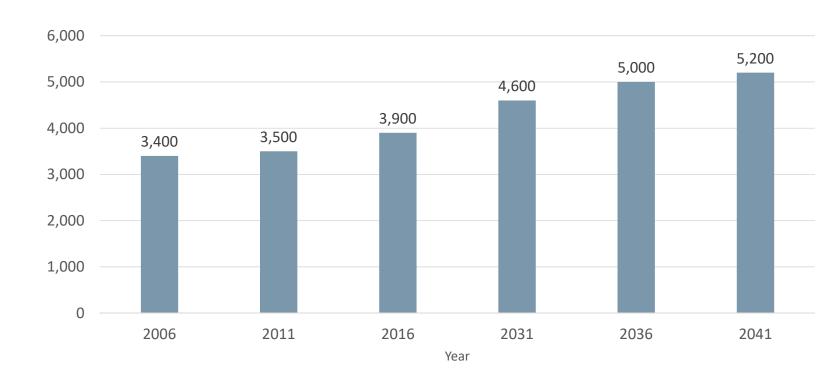
