












HILLSBURGH GRAVITY SEWER **CONTACT INFORMATION & FAQS**

Contract: 2022-04W

As part of the ongoing construction of the Hillsburgh Gravity Sewer along Trafalgar Road, we are providing you with this bulletin to keep you informed and address any concerns that may arise during this construction phase. We understand that construction can be disruptive, and we greatly appreciate your continued patience and cooperation.

In the event of unforeseen circumstances or emergencies related to the construction, please refer to the procedures outlined below and contact the appropriate parties specified in this bulletin. For emergencies such as fire, medical, or police, please call 9-1-1. For all other concerns or issues, please utilize the contact information provided.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Where will my water and sewer services be placed?
- During the construction, water services and sewer laterals will be laid up to the property line at the center of your property. If this conflicts with the placement of your septic system, please contact the Town of Erin as detailed below as soon as possible so we can assist you in finding a suitable resolution to the situation.
- What should I do if my water supply is affected by construction activities?
 - During the pipe installation process, dewatering operations in nearby trenches may affect or temporarily interrupt your well water supply. If you experience any issues with your well water, please contact the Town of Erin. In coordination with the Construction Team, they will arrange to provide a temporary alternate supply of water via water tank and bottled water to your property until well supply is restored.
- Who do I contact if I lose internet, cable or land-line service?
 - If the construction work breaks the underground service lines to your property, the Contractor will make arrangements with the telecommunication provider to restore the service as soon as possible. Otherwise, please contact your respective telecommunications provider for assistance.
- Who do I contact if I lose power?
 - Please contact Hydro One at 800-957-7756.
- What should I do if I have concerns regarding flooding that are believed to be related to construction activities?

While utmost care is taken during construction to minimize the risk of flooding, it is possible that heavy rain events may cause water to encroach onto properties. If you encounter flooding related to construction activities, please first ensure your safety and evacuate the affected area, if necessary. Once in a safe area, please notify the Town of Erin. We will work with the

Construction Team to address the issue promptly.

— What should I do if I suspect there is a gas line break?

If the construction work breaks a gas line service or main, the Contractor will make arrangements with the gas supplier to restore the service as soon as possible. The Construction Team is wellprepared to handle such situations and has established procedures in place to promptly address any potential impacts to surrounding properties in the event of a gas service or main strike. They will take immediate action and work closely with the Town's Fire Department to ensure the safety of the public.

If you suspect a gas line break within your house, do not attempt to investigate the issue yourself but please first ensure your safety and evacuate the affected area and then once in a safe place, call the Town's Fire Department.

- Can I contact the Contractor if I need some information or want to convey some information? The proper of line of communication for the public regarding the construction works is to contact the Town of Erin as detailed below.
- What are the detour routes for the Trafalgar Road closure?

Detour 1 (for vehicles) and Detour 2 (for trucks) are in place to direct vehicles and trucks around the closure of Trafalgar Road.

Other detours in the Hillsburgh area, Detours 3, 4 & 5, are detour routes associated with the closure of Sideroad 17.

ERIN VILLAGE GRAVITY SEWER

Contract: 2022-04W

Starting on July 10th, construction of the sanitary gravity sewer construction along Main Street in Erin Village will commence. The construction work will extend along Main Street between the Elora-Cataract Trail and Dianne Road, and along Water Street from Main Street to Hillview Avenue. The sewer installation will utilize microtunneling, a trenchless pipe installation method. As part of this process, microtunneling shafts will be installed at specific locations along Main Street, as indicated on the map provided on the following page.

Prior to shaft installation, utility relocations will be required at certain shaft locations to accommodate the sewer installation. This will involve relocating cables for Bell telecommunications, street lighting, and traffic signals. Once the utility relocations are completed, the installation of the microtunneling shafts will proceed sequentially.

To ensure the safety of workers, road users, and residents, concrete barriers will be in place around each shaft location. Two-way traffic flow will be maintained on Main Street, and road jogs will be implemented where necessary to accommodate the shaft construction.

Lane or road closures may be required on certain local roads to facilitate utility relocation and/or shaft installation, as illustrated in the map of the work area. During this period, properties on the affected local roads can be accessed via Daniel Street or Lion's Park Avenue from Main Street. Access to local homes, businesses, and emergency services will be maintained at all times.

> Construction Start: July 10, 2023 Anticipated Completion: September 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience increased truck traffic, dirt on roads, dust and noise. The Town, along with the Contactor, will make every effort to minimize these impacts to the community.
- The Town will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on Town or County property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours or on weekends may be required during the course of construction.



Open for Business: Local businesses will be open throughout construction. All are welcome! Businesses with any construction-related concerns are advised to contact the Town.












Construction Update - Project Overview














Construction Update – Hillsburgh Gravity Sewer









Micro-tunneling Method – Typical Compound








































NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE

Culvert 10 Replacement 17th Sideroad Contract No.: 300053088.1000

The Town of Erin hereby notifies and advises all local residents that Culvert 10 located on 17th Sideroad, approximately 1.4 km east of Trafalgar Road will be:

Closed for Replacement beginning Wednesday, July 12, 2023

Culvert 10 is required to be replaced due to public safety concerns. At present, the Culvert Replacement is expected to be completed by November 2023, however there is a possibility the construction may take longer based on uncertainties in the weather. Local access will be maintained at all times for residents, and businesses from either the west or the east, however, through access will not be permitted during construction. There will be no access to 8th Line north from 17th sideroad. A map illustrating the project location and closure section is attached, for reference.

All agencies, such as, but not limited to; Emergency Services, Student Transportation Services, Waste Collection and Postal Service will all be notified of the road closure. Every effort will be made to ensure there is minimal or no disruption to the services they provide. Road closure notification signs will be installed and maintained throughout the project.


Town of Erin – Culvert 10 Replacement

Map of Proposed Bridge Closure & Detour Routes


Detour 1 will utilize County Road 23 and County Road 22

Detour 3 will utilize Trafalgar Road, County Road 124, Dundas Street, and 8th Line
















Culvert 10 Replacement – 17th Sideroad
