To help celebrate Canada's Sesquicentennial (150 years) of Confederation and the founding of the Province of Ontario, the Town of Erin commissioned a piece to be crafted and researched to honour past Reeves and Mayors of Erin. It represents our community and former local Councillors, through the leadership of Reeves and Mayors of the Township, Village and now the Town of Erin.

Local artist Ofer Dagan designed and created the piece with assistance and historical research by Jeff Duncan and the County of Wellington Archives staff. Ofer is a European trained craftsman with over 40 years of wood working experience. The frame is from three locally sourced woods: cherry, maple and walnut. The cherry wood was donated by Mayor Allan Alls. The frame is entirely hand crafted and natural in colour, with no stains or metal hardware used in the construction. It took just over 100 hours to create.
