

Vote by Mail

Qualified electors within the Town of Erin will be casting their ballots in the 2010 Municipal Election by way of Canada Post. Voter Kits will be mailed to every qualified elector whose name appears on the Voter's List. Upon receiving the Voter Kit, the elector will complete their Kit and return the ballot package to the Municipal Clerk's Office either through the regular mail or by dropping the ballot package off at one of our ballot return stations.



On Voting Day, **Monday, October 25, 2010**, the Municipal Clerk and designated election personnel will count the votes and declare the election results.

What is included in the Voter Kit?

Each qualified elector shall receive an envelope containing the following:

What to do if you didn't receive a Voter Kit

If a qualified elector does not receive a Voter Kit or if the Voter Kit is lost or destroyed, a new Voter Kit may only be issued by attending at the Town of Erin Municipal Office, 5684 Trafalgar Rd., Hillsburgh, ON N0B 1Z0 after October 12, 2010, during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday). The Municipal Clerk, or designate, will verify the elector's eligibility to vote. If the elector is qualified to vote, and is not already on the Voter's List, an Application to Amend the Voter's List shall be completed and signed to add the elector's name to the Voter's List, and the elector will then be provided with a Voter Kit.

The Elector will have the opportunity to take the Voter Kit home with them to complete their ballot, or to complete the Kit at the Municipal Office.

I accidentally spoiled my ballot. Can I get a replacement ballot?

If you have accidentally spoiled your ballot, you may attend the Town of Erin Municipal Office,
