## ADDITIONAL WASTE DIVERSION PROGRAMMES

**BACKYARD COMPOSTING**—Backyard compost all fruit & vegetable scraps, leaf & yard waste, etc. SWS sells backyard composters at County waste facilities.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)**—

Dispose of HHW safely & properly! The County operates seven annual HHW Event Days, five year-round Selected HHW Depots and an Alkaline Battery Recycling Programme at County libraries. *Residential service only.*

**SCRAP METAL—APPLIANCES—TIRES—WOOD/BRUSH—REUSE CENTRES**

Contact SWS for waste facility locations, hours/days of operation, fees, etc.
