



Erin raises Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation's Flag

Today, on National Indigenous Peoples Day, the Town of Erin announces that we will be commemorating the start of a meaningful relationship with Mississaugas of the Credit First Nations and our neighbouring Indigenous communities with a formal flag exchange and official flag raising on July 1, 2018.

Former Chief of the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nations, Carolyn King, will be present and will speak about the land and the history of the property. The ceremony will take place at Town Hall at 11:00 AM on July 1.

"The Town is working towards creating a formal Land Acknowledgement where we are able to recognize that the land on which we gather is part of the Treaty Lands and Territory of the Mississaugas of the Credit", said Mayor Alls. "Developing our relationship with the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nations is incredibly important to us and we are honoured to have former Chief, Carolyn King, at our ceremony", he added.
