Pursuant to Section 45 of *The Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990

Purpose

The purpose of this application is to provide relief from Zoning By-law 07-67 specifically section 6.1.2 Table 6 to permit a reduced side yard setback of 0.59 m (1.9 ft) and a reduced front yard setback of 5.59 m (18.3 ft). This does not meet the required side yard setback of 3.0 m (9.84 ft) by 2.4 m (7.9 ft) or the required front yard setback of 6.0 m (19.68 ft) by 0.05 m (0.16 ft) for the main dwelling.

The applicants are also seeking relief from Section 4.47 to permit a porch/deck yard encroachment into the interior side yard of 0.4 m (1.3 ft).

The applicants are also seeking relief from Section 4.26.3 to permit parking in front of the main building. The Zoning By-law requires parking to be to the rear of the front wall of the main building.

Decision and Reasons of the Committee

It is the decision of the Committee of Adjustment to approve this variance application for the following reasons:


- The variance is minor in nature;
- The proposed minor variance represents appropriate use of the subject property;
- The requested variance conforms to the general intent and purpose of the Town of Erin Official Plan;
- The requested variance conforms to the general intent and purpose of the Town of Erin By-Law #07-67.

With the following condition related to section 4.26.3 to permit parking in front of the main building:


- The applicant must obtain an access permit from the County of Wellington.

Appeals

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Erin Committee of Adjustment before the minor variance is granted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Erin Committee of Adjustment to the Local Planning Tribunal (LPAT.)

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Erin Committee of Adjustment before the minor variance is granted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Any appeals of the Decision of the Town of Erin Committee of Adjustment must be filed with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee of Adjustment, **not later than the 7th day of May, 2019** setting out the reasons for the appeal together with a certified cheque or money order in the amount of \$300.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.
