Station Street Dam and Bridge – Notice of Completion Extension

As a condition of the Non-Application - Emergency Work under the Lakes and Rivers Improvement Act for the repairs to the Hillsburgh Dam, issued by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry on July 19, 2012; the Town of Erin is required to determine a permanent solution for the dam.
