Town of Erin Open Air Burning

Be advised that as of 10:30 a.m. the Town of Erin has lifted the ban on open air burning within the Town of Erin.

Open air burning includes bonfires, campfires, burn barrels, outdoor fireplaces/chimineas or any other fire in open air.

The community's cooperation throughout the ban is appreciated. The Town of Erin's Fire and Emergency Services will advise if there are any further changes to the status of the permits.

Please ensure that a Burn Permit is obtained all fire preventative measures are taken in advance if you are considering any type of open air burning.

Burn bans are posted on the Town of Erin website at www.erin.ca and published in local newspapers. Before you burn, to verify if there is a burning ban imposed by the Fire Chief, please call the Town Office at 519.855.4407 or toll free at 1.877.818.2888 Monday to Friday between 8:30am and 4:30pm, except holidays.
