## WINTER WEATHER CAN CREATE DIFFICULT DRIVING CONDITIONS

- Let a friend or family member know where you are going and your route.
- Clear all snow and ice from your vehicle before heading out.
- Turn on your vehicle's full lighting system in poor visibility.
- Adjust speed for road conditions and give yourself extra time.
- Stay well back of snow ploughs. Do not pass a snow plough on the right-hand side.
- Do not use your cruise control on wet, snowy or icy pavement.
- Keep your gas tank half full.
- Replace all-season tires with snow tires for driving in winter weather.
- Assemble or purchase an emergency car kit.
