



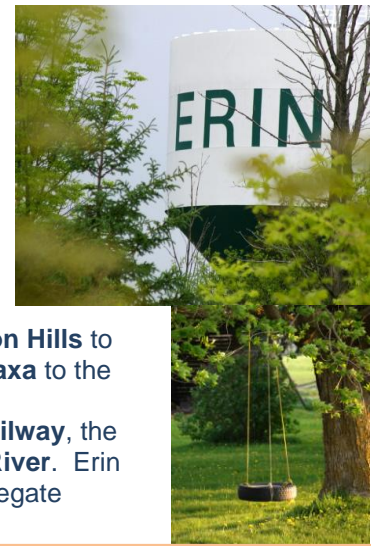
## WELCOME TO THE TOWN OF ERIN

The **Town of Erin** is primarily a rural municipality with a population of **11,148 citizens**. The Town is characterized by open space, rolling hills, farmlands, wetlands, watercourses, forest features and small urban settlements.

We have two urban centres, **Erin** and **Hillsburgh** surrounded by a natural rural area which includes six hamlets: **Ballinafad, Brisbane, Cedar Valley, Crewson's Corners, Orton** and **Ospringe**.

We are bordered by the **Town of Caledon** to the east, the **Town of Halton Hills** to the south, the **Township of Guelph/Eramosa** to the west and the **Township of East Garafraxa** to the north.

The Town of Erin contains many natural and cultural features such as the **Elora Cataract Trailway**, the headwaters of the **West Credit River** and two important headwater tributaries of the **Grand River**. Erin also has a vital agricultural community and resource-based uses such as recreation and aggregate extraction.
