Erin Rotary Riverwalk Logo Contest Winner

The Rotary Club of Erin congratulates Riley Dowling as winner of the Erin Rotary Riverwalk Logo Contest.

Riley's design statement describes the interconnectedness of the Town of Erin with the West Credit River. A dark band represents a bridge between the town and a more developed use of the beautiful West Credit River. This demonstrates how the Erin Rotary Riverwalk will connect the citizens of Erin and Hillsburgh to the river and the landscape around them.

Riley is a graduate of Erin District High school who is now enrolled in the Bachelor of Film and Television program at Sheridan College.

The Erin Rotary Riverwalk is a joint project between the Town of Erin and the Rotary Club of Erin. Phase 1 is expected to be completed this year. It will proceed from Riverside Park at Church Street in Erin village and follow the river downstream to an observation platform. The multi-year Erin Rotary Riverwalk project will eventually feature riverside trails in Erin and a mill pond trail in Hillsburgh. It will connect the villages via the Elora Cataract Trail.
