



Water Quality

The operations of the Town of Erin's water systems are regulated under the Safe Drinking Water Act and the Ontario Water Resources Act. Regulation 170/03 under the Safe Drinking Water Act dictates the monitoring and water quality checking that must be completed to ensure that the water supplied to the consumer is safe for consumption.

Water Hardness

Erin Municipal Water System

Well # 7 - Hardness of around 300Mgl [17.5 Grains/US Gal.]

Well #8 - 370 Mgl [21.6 Grains/US Gal.]

As the water from Well #7 and Well #8 are blended, it is recommended that the settings on your water softener be set to 19.5 grains/US Gal for the Erin Distribution System.

Hillsburgh Municipal Water System

Hillsburgh Heights Well #2 - 250Mgl [14.6 Grains/US Gal.] - Upper Pressure Zone.

Glendevon Well #3 - 390 Mgl [22.8 Grains/US Gal.] – Lower Pressure Zone.
