THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ERIN

BY-LAW # 02 - 86

Being a By-Law to revise By-Law #94-10 (a By-Law to regulate the operation of Motorized Snow Vehicles within the Town of Erin).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. Chapter 44, By-laws may be passed by councils of Local Municipalities for regulating, governing or prohibiting the operation of motorized snow vehicles;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and appropriate to establish regulations respecting motorized snow vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ERIN HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-Law # 94 10 is hereby amended by revising the following sections:
 - (a) "Sidewalk" means and includes boulevards and that part of the municipal road allowance which is improved, designed and intended for the use of pedestrians;
 - (b) "Highway" means and includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles;
 - (c) "Serviced roadway" means the part of highway that is improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, and includes the ploughed portion of the shoulder, and, where a highway includes two or more separate serviced roadways, the term "serviced roadway" refers to any one serviced roadway separately and not to all of the serviced roadways collectively.
- 2. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle on any sidewalk, walkway, boulevard, or other route used exclusively for pedestrian travel within the Town of Erin
- 3. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine pursuant to the Provincial Offenses Act.
- 4. That this By-Law repeals former Village of Erin By-Law numbers 96-11 and 94-10 and the former Township of Erin By-Law #12-75 and shall come into effect upon its final passage.
