#### Equipment Operator (Contract)

The Town of Erin Roads Department requires Equipment Operators (6 positions available) from **November 2020 until April 2021**. Duties include, but are not limited to, performing the day-to-day general operations of the Roads Department, which includes roads and equipment, operations and maintenance, operating light and heavy equipment such as snow plow equipment, salt and sand spreader, front end loader, grader, excavator, tractor and attachments, and following all safety procedures, legislation and municipal policies and procedures.

Minimum qualifications for this position include:

- A valid Class "D" with a "Z" endorsement Ontario Driver's License and satisfactory driver's abstract;
- Secondary school graduate with courses in T.J. Mahoney Road School and/or C.S. Anderson Road School preferred;
- Valid First Aid and CPR Certification;
- Excellent skills in public relations, communications and problem solving;
- Knowledge of relevant legislation (OTM, HTA, MMA, OHSA, etc.)
- Must be a motivated and ambitious individual, able to work independently with minimal supervision and in a team environment;
