

## The Corporation of the Town of Erin Roads Department Winter Equipment Operator (Temporary)

The Town of Erin Roads Department requires Equipment Operators from **October 31**<sup>st</sup> **2022 until April 14**<sup>th</sup> **2023**. Duties include, but are not limited to, performing the day-to-day general operations of the Roads Department, which includes roads and equipment, operations and maintenance, operating light and heavy equipment such as snow plow equipment, salt and sand spreader, front end loader, grader, excavator, tractor and attachments, and following all safety procedures, legislation and municipal policies and procedures.

Minimum qualifications for this position include:

- A valid Class "D" with a "Z" endorsement Ontario Driver's License and satisfactory driver's abstract;
- Secondary school graduate with courses in T.J. Mahoney Road School and/or C.S. Anderson Road School preferred but not required;
- Valid First Aid and CPR Certification;
- Excellent skills in public relations, communications and problem solving;
- Knowledge of relevant legislation (OTM, HTA, MMA, OHSA, etc.)
- Must be a motivated and ambitious individual, able to work independently with minimal supervision and in a team environment;
- Ability to read maps and follow directions;
- Must be able to provide proof of full vaccination against covid-19.

Note: This position is being offered on a contract basis working 80 hours bi-weekly working mostly evenings and weekends (subject to change). The contract period begins on Monday October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 and ceases on Friday April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
