HILLSBURGH GRAVITY SEWER

Contract: 2022-04W

Installation of the sanitary gravity sewer and watermain along Trafalgar Road in Hillsburgh highlighted as the red line on the map below is anticipated to commence this month, March 2023. No throughtraffic will be allowed through the work area, but access to local homes and businesses as well as emergency services will be maintained at all times.

WORK DETAILS

The Town's Contractor will be installing a sanitary gravity sewer and watermain along Trafalgar Road in Hillsburgh, (approx. 1 km) to support the needs of the community by removing reliance on existing septic systems while creating new opportunities for measured growth within the community for the foreseeable future. This work is part of the Council-approved Erin Wastewater Servicing Project (refer to description on last page).

Starting in March 2023, the Town's Contractor will close off the work area to through-traffic, move equipment on-site and prepare the work area before construction begins. Construction crews will then:

- Install erosion and sediment control measures
- Excavate to install the gravity sewer and watermain
- Install water and sewer services to the property line of each property along the work area
- Reconstruct the roadway including road, curbs and sidewalks
- Complete final site works and restore disturbed areas to original or better condition

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Due to the open-cut construction method required for the installation of the gravity sewer and watermain, the work area along Trafalgar Road between Upper Canada Drive/Church Street and the Elora Cataract Trail access point will be closed to through-traffic for the duration of construction. Local access for residents, businesses, emergency vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times.
- Through-traffic will be required to follow detour routes which will be clearly marked with traffic signs along the approach roads into Hillsburgh. Detour routes for vehicular traffic are posted on the Town's website.
- You may experience other inconveniences such as increased truck traffic, dirt on roads, dust and noise. The Town, along with the Contactor, will make every effort to minimize these impacts to the community.
- The Town will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on Town or County property.

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours or on weekends may be required during the course of construction.
8	Traffic Management : Efforts will be made to manage traffic around the work area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on Wellington Road 22, Sideroad 17, Hwy 124, Winston Churchill Boulevard and Erin Garafraxa Townline.
	Hillsburgh through-traffic along Trafalgar Road will be redirected to Winston Churchill Boulevard via Wellington Road 22 and Erin Garafraxa Townline during the construction period.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION (CONT'D)

$\langle \gamma \rangle$	Detour Routes: Detour routes for vehicular traffic can be found on the Town's website. Detour road signs will be in place prior to the closure of Trafalgar Road.

WASTEWATER SERVICING PROJECT BACKGROUND

In August 2019, the Town of Erin completed the Urban Centre Wastewater Servicing Schedule 'C' Class EA process which investigated and determined the preferred Wastewater Servicing solution for the existing residents and future developments within Erin Village and the community of Hillsburgh.

The preferred Wastewater Servicing solution included the following infrastructure (see map on last page):



WASTEWATER SERVICING PROJECT BACKGROUND (CONT'D)

- Sanitary gravity sewer in Hillsburgh along Trafalgar Road
- Sanitary gravity sewer along the Elora-Cataract Trail from Hillsburgh to Erin Village
- Sanitary gravity sewer in Erin Village along Main St.
- Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) located in Lion's Club Park in Erin Village
- Twin sanitary forcemains from the SPS to the Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF)
- WRRF including effluent sewer and outfall

Construction of the Wastewater Servicing project is anticipated to take approximately 20 more months to complete with different sections being constructed at different times depending on the area and method of construction.
