ERIN SEWAGE PUMPING STATION TREE REMOVAL

Contract: 2022-03W


The Town will be constructing a Sewage Pumping Station in the Lions' Club Park in Erin Village as part of the Council-approved Erin Wastewater Servicing Project.

Prior to the start of construction, the Town's Contractor will be removing trees and vegetation within the site work area, as shown in the map below. The tree removal work is anticipated to start the week of March 20, 2023 and be completed within a week.

All trees and shrubs that are removed will be replaced with new trees and shrubs once construction of the Sewage Pumping Station is completed, and Lions' Club Park will be restored to its original, or better condition.

Anticipated Tree Removal Period: March 20 – March 30, 2023 Anticipated Construction Period: May 2023 – September 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING TREE REMOVAL IN THE PARK

- You may experience inconveniences such as restrictions to park areas, increased truck traffic around the park, dirt on roads, dust and noise. The Town, along with the Contactor, will make every effort to minimize these impacts to the community.
- The Town will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on Town or County property.

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours or on weekends may be required during the course of construction.
÷	Area Restrictions: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be restrictions around the park area. The Town's Contractor will be erecting temporary fencing around the tree removal work area; the public are restricted from entering the fenced area.
