Wastewater Infrastructure Construction Update

**Concerns Have Been Raised by Local
Hillsburgh Businesses and Residents**

Town of Erin Commits to Improvements - Read
Below for Details

Good Morning Members,

As so many of us are acutely aware, construction of the wastewater infrastructure along Trafalgar Road in Hillsburgh is underway. The past few days have been extremely difficult due to the construction, with unanticipated total road closures and a complete lack of effective resident and business communication.

We have been receiving, hearing and sharing your concerns. Erin Chamber has been active with posts, calls to the Town, communication to the Mayor and Council, and a very direct email to Nick Colucci the Director of Infrastructure for the Town of Erin. A few changes have already happened with the expectation of further improvements in the coming days.

The Town of Erin has committed to working with their contractor to ensure that single lane access through the construction zone on Trafalgar Road will be maintained. While there will be significant delays during the daytime while active work is occurring, flag persons are being directed to let vehicles know that the construction zone - and businesses within it - are open. An additional local detour route will also be posted to downtown Hillsburgh along 8th Line to Orangeville Street to encourage easier access. More signage indicating that businesses are open are on the way.

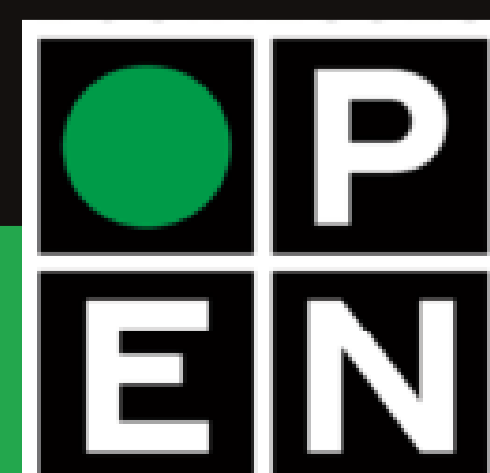
The Town is working on a proposal for improved communication and this is being reviewed with input from the Liaison Committee. You will receive updates on it as soon as we do.

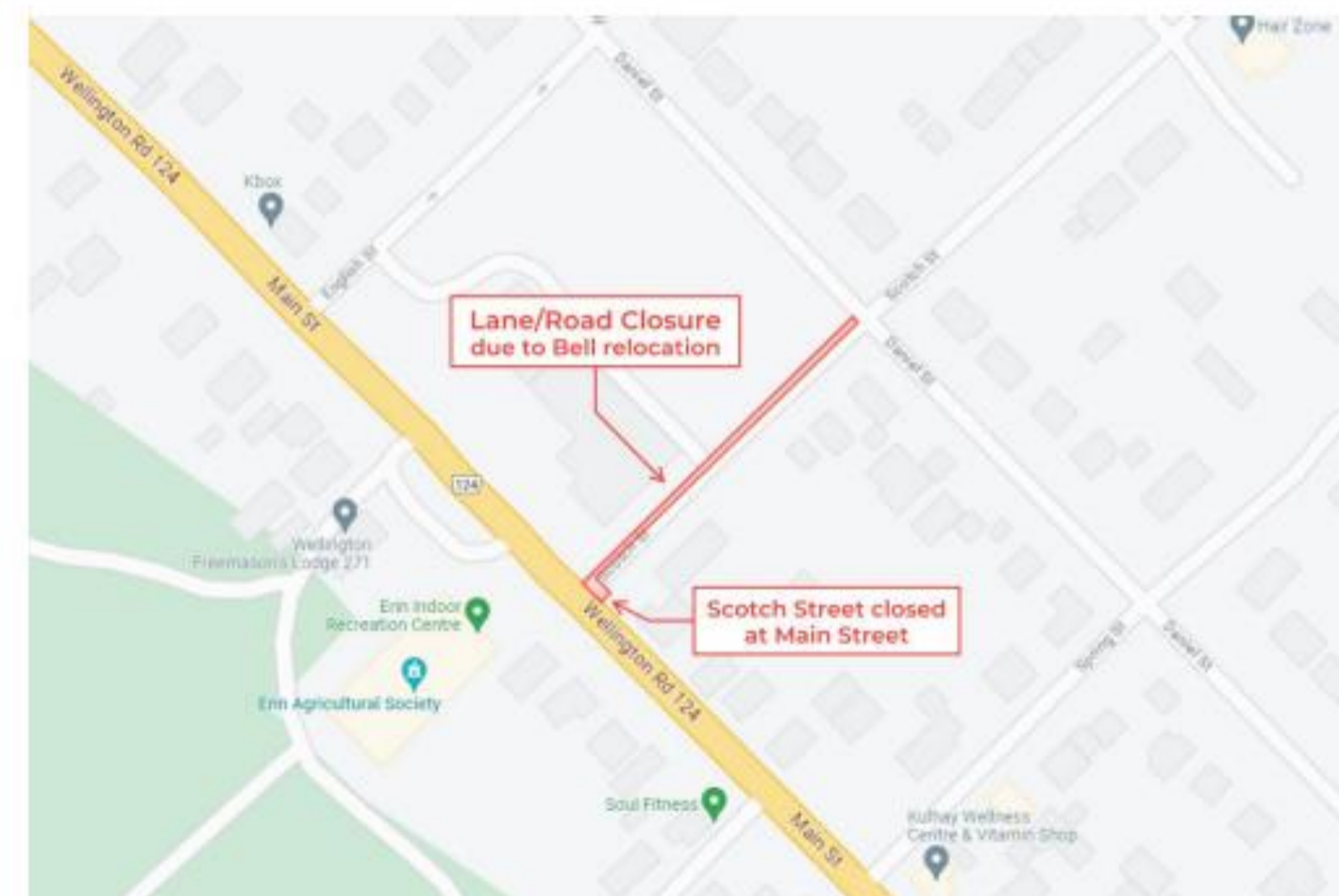

Currently, the Bell lines on Main Street at Scotch Street are being relocated to facilitate the construction of the upcoming microtunneling shaft in that location. As a result, there is a lane closure in effect along Scotch Street between Main Street and Daniel Street.

Please be advised that a road closure on Scotch Street at Main Street will be implemented starting the week of May 29th. The lane / road closure area is highlighted in red on the map below.

During this process, properties on Scotch Street can be accessed via Daniel Street and either English Street or Spring Street from Main Street. Access to local homes, businesses, and emergency services will be maintained at all times.

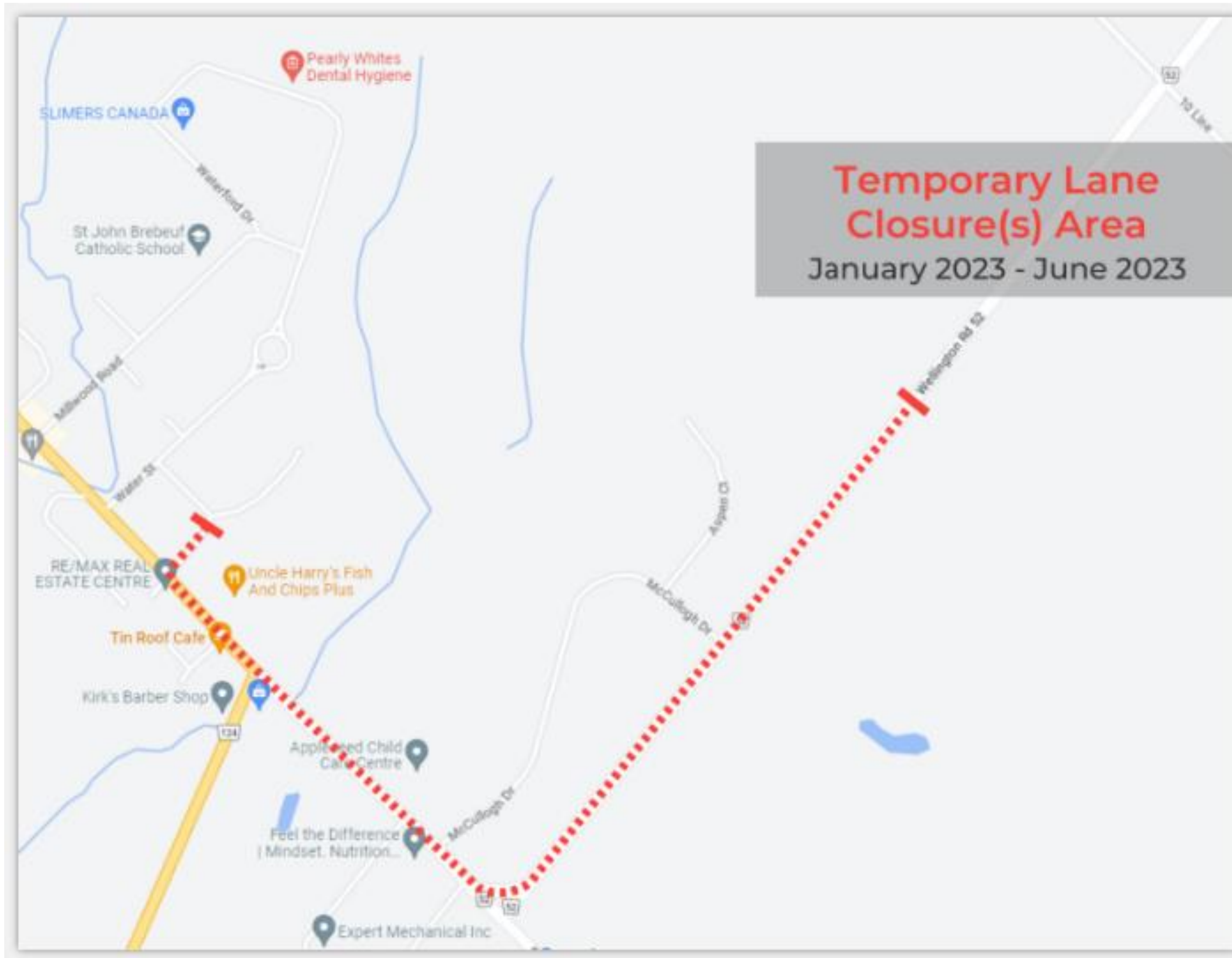
Erin WRRF Effluent Sewer



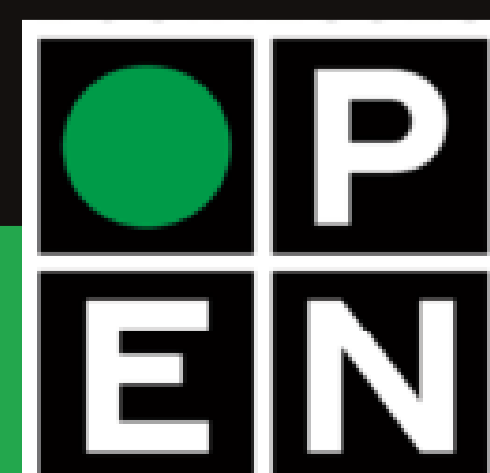

4. An additional local detour route will be posted to downtown Hillsburgh along 8th Line to Orangeville Street. These will include the OPEN signage.
 5. We will develop a weekly notice that will be issued showing the current construction work zone where there is a lane closure and what areas should be accessed from the north or south. This will assist residents and business to plan their trips and deliveries;
 6. Municipal 511 will be updated with the closure area;
 7. The contractor and our consultant will be talking directly to the School and local businesses;
 8. OPEN and DIG ERIN signage is on order and will be erected as soon as they arrive.

Hillsburgh Gravity Sewer - Updates

1. Single lane access through the construction zone will be maintained. There may be large delays in this zone during the day. Traffic signals will be in place during the evenings and weekends;
2. Flag persons will be letting vehicles know that the construction zone is open but to expect large delays and will be distributing a construction notice flyer showing the detour routes for their next trip to Town;
3. All digital signs will be programmed to include "DOWNTOWN BUSINESSES OPEN" and "EXPECT DELAYS" messaging;
4. An additional local detour route will be posted to downtown Hillsburgh along 8th Line to Orangeville Street. These will include the OPEN signage.
5. We will develop a weekly notice that will be issued showing the current construction work zone where there is a lane closure and what areas should be accessed from the north or south. This will assist residents and business to plan their trips and deliveries;
6. Municipal 511 will be updated with the closure area;
7. The contractor and our consultant will be talking directly to the School and local businesses;
8. OPEN and DIG ERIN signage is on order and will be erected as soon as they arrive;



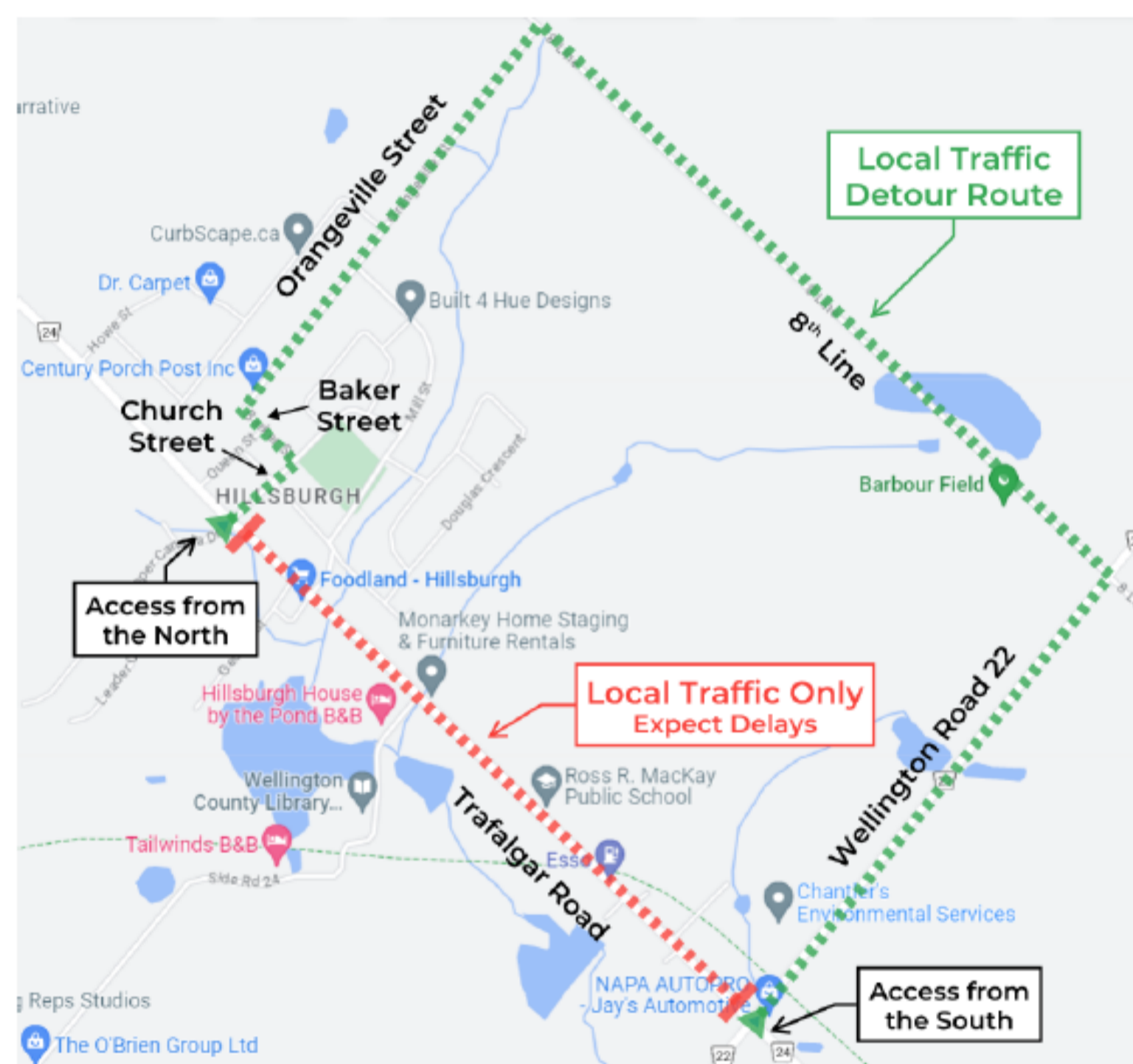

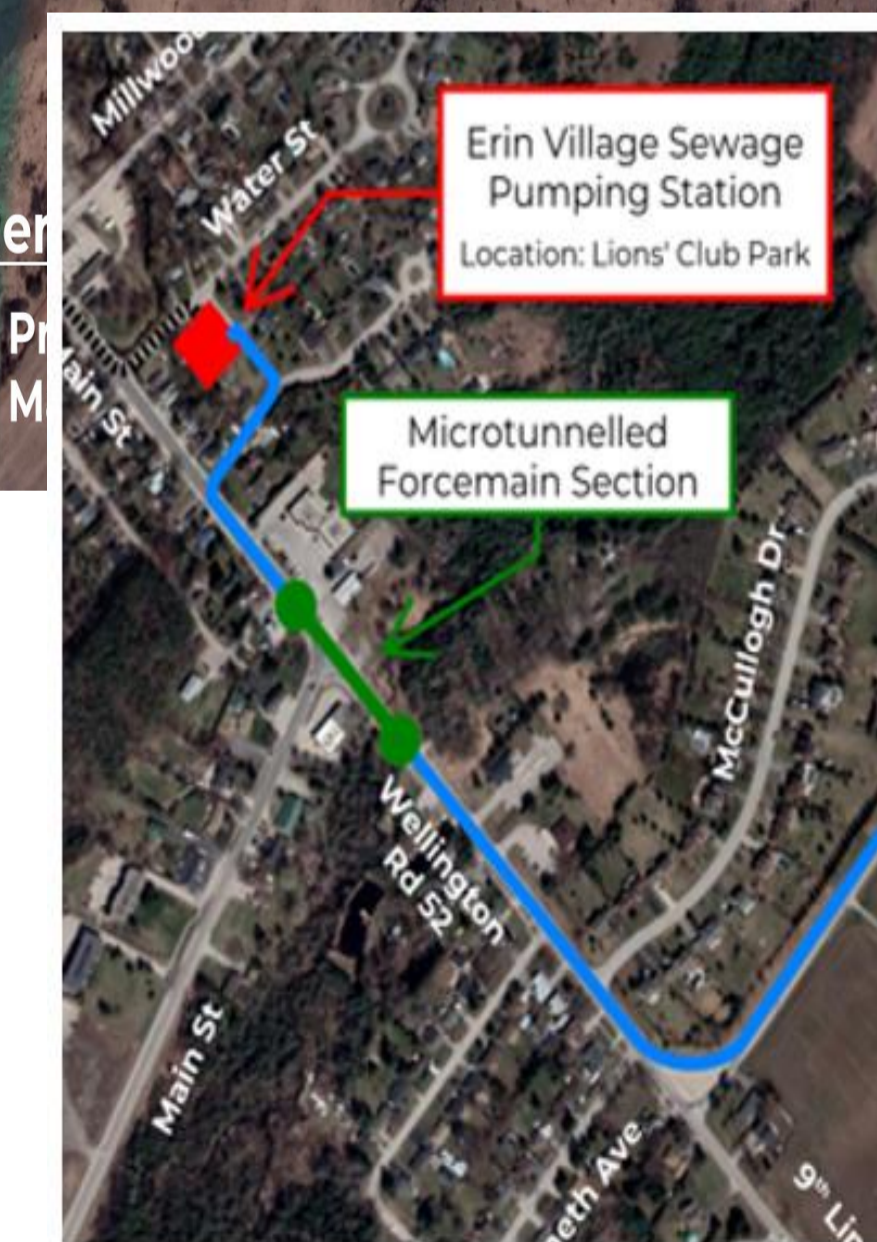
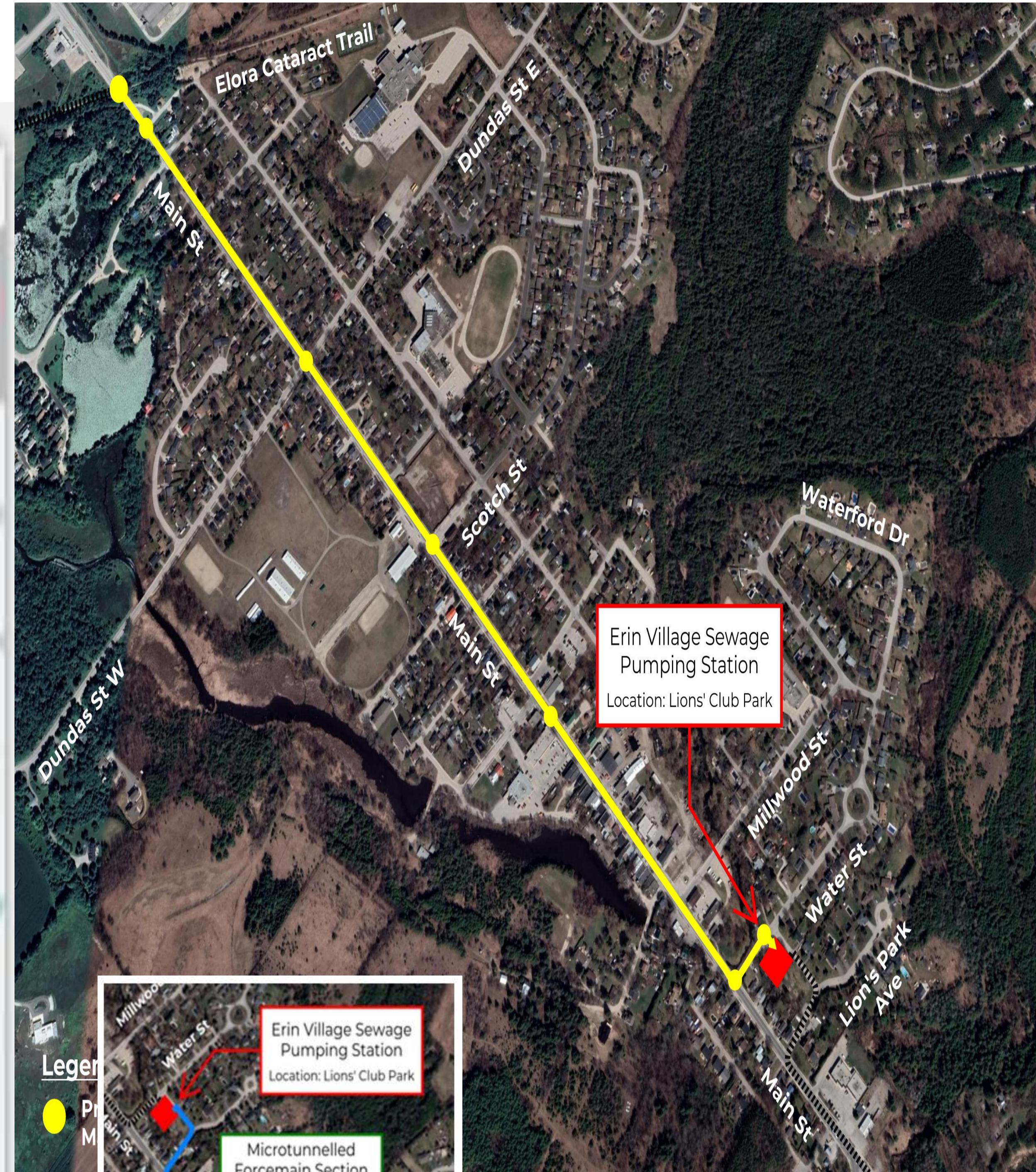
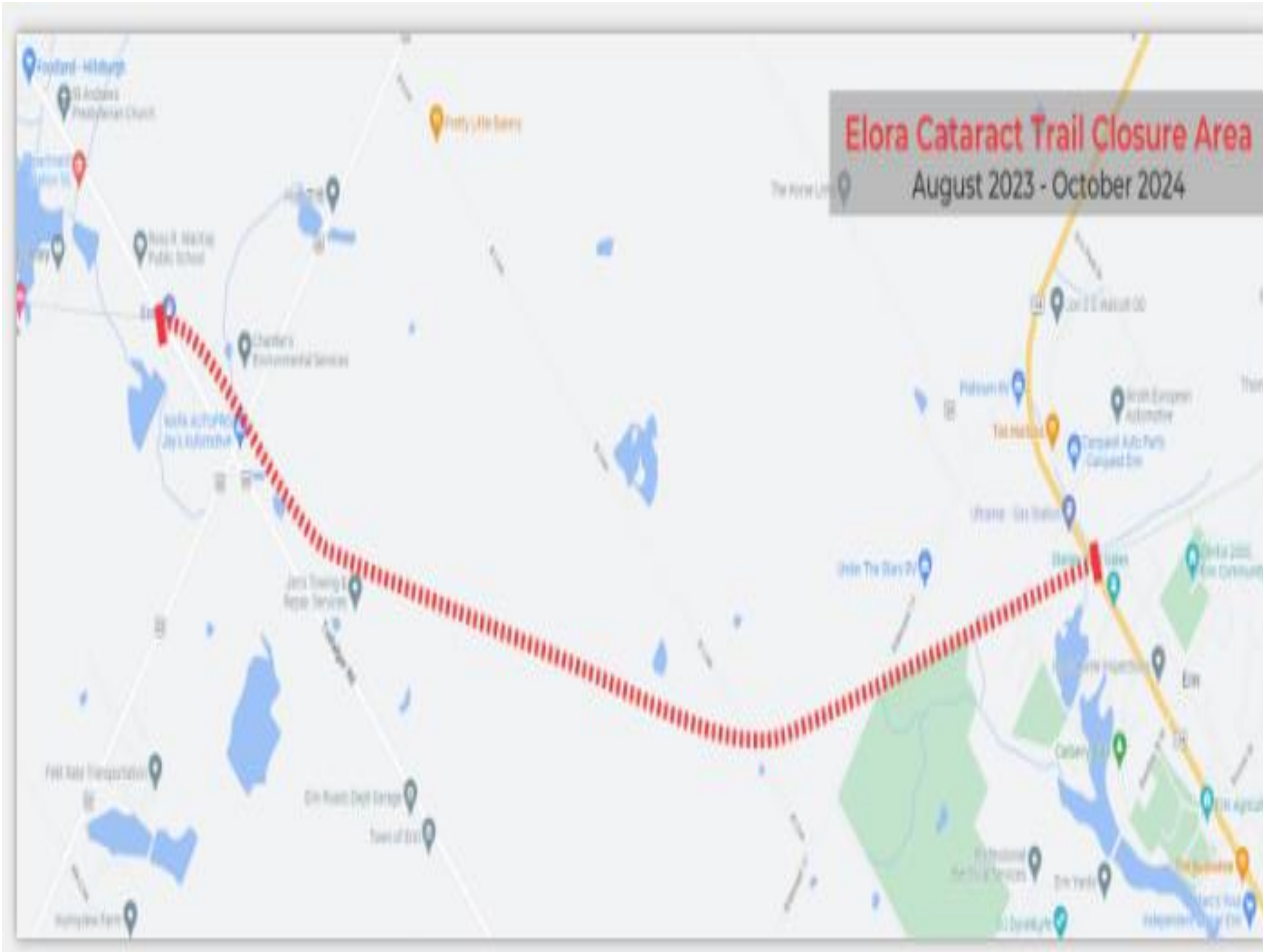
Construction Update - Elora-Cataract Gravity Sewer



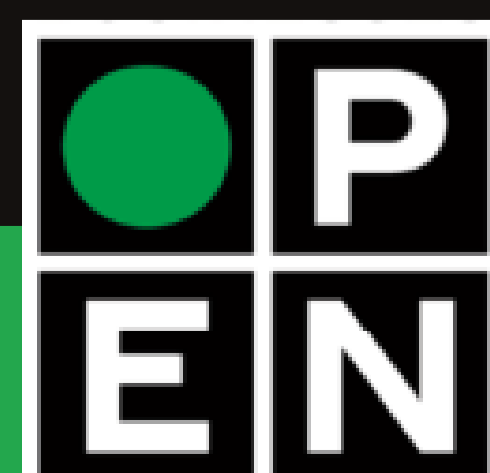

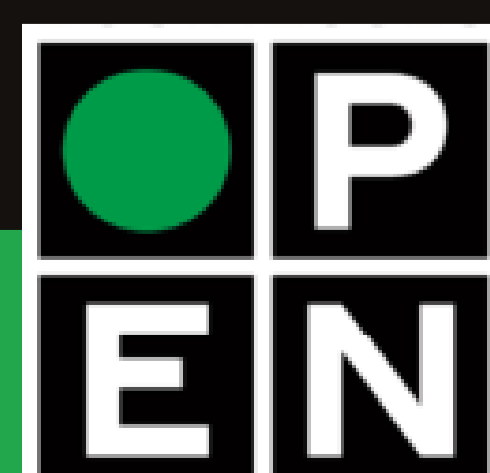
MAP OF THE WORK AREA
