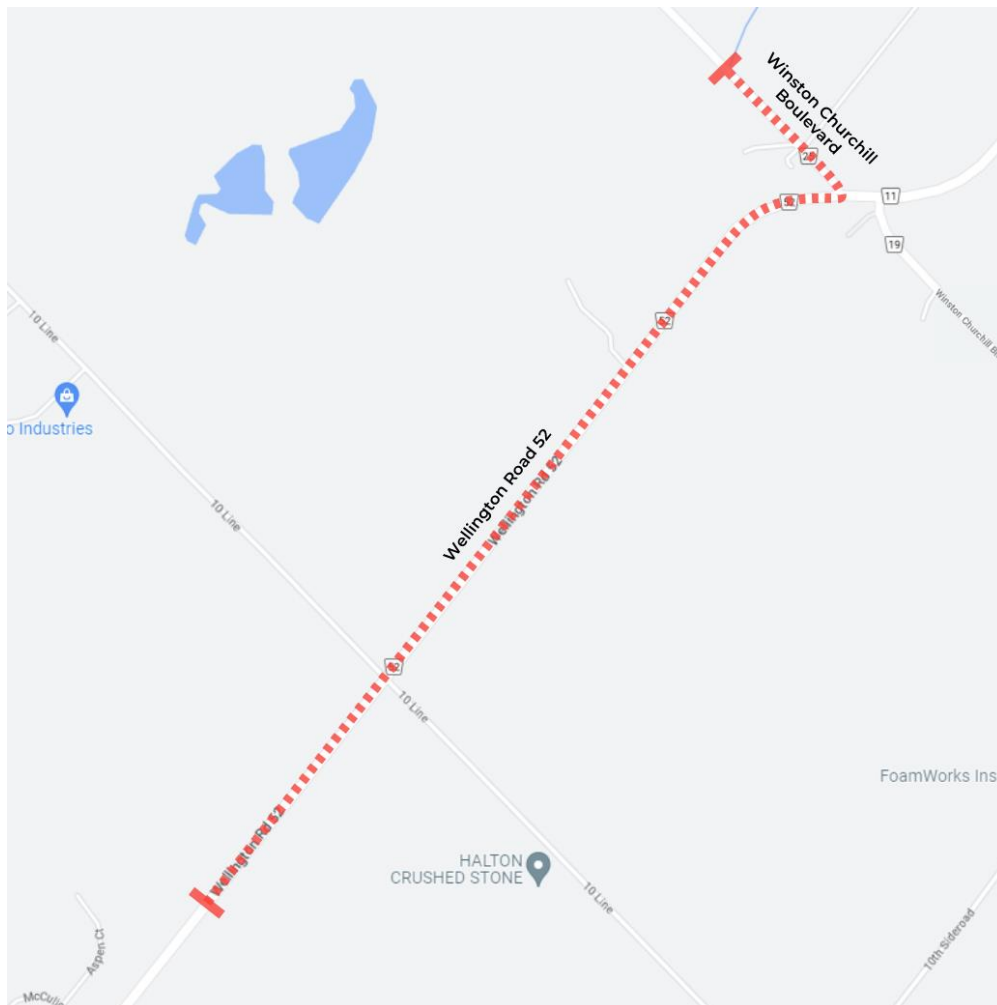
Installation of the treated effluent sewer from the Erin Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) along Wellington Road 52 and Winston Churchill Boulevard in the Town of Erin, identified by the red line on the map below, commenced in early April 2023. Lane and road closures will be required throughout the course of construction, but access to local homes and businesses as well as emergency services will be maintained at all times.

Construction Start: April 2023

Anticipated Construction Completion: September 2023

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CURRENT WORK DETAILS





The Town’s Contractor has begun installing sanitary twin forcemains and a gravity sewer to convey treated effluent from the Erin WRRF along Wellington Road 52 and Winston Churchill Boulevard to the West Credit River (approx. 2 km).

Starting on May 24, 2023, the Town’s Contractor will close off the section of the work area on Winston Churchill Boulevard for four weeks. The contractor is on-site and has prepared the construction area for the installation of the gravity sewer. Disturbed areas will be restored to original or better condition.

The road closure on Winston Churchill Boulevard will be followed by a lane closure along Wellington Road 52 for a period of two weeks. This lane closure is required to complete the connection between the gravity sewer on Winston Churchill Boulevard and the forcemain at the intersection of Winston Churchill Boulevard and Wellington Road 52.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- **Local access for residents, emergency vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Road signs will notify drivers of upcoming road closures.**
- During the road closure, through-traffic will be required to follow detour routes which will be clearly marked with traffic signs along the approach roads into the work area. Detour routes for vehicular traffic are posted on the Town’s website.
- You may experience other inconveniences such as increased truck traffic, dirt on roads, dust and noise. The Town, along with the Contactor, will make every effort to minimize these impacts to the community.
- The Town will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on Town or County property.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours or on weekends may be required during the course of construction.
	Traffic Management: Efforts will be made to manage traffic around the work area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays on Wellington Road 52 and Winston Churchill Boulevard as well as increased traffic along Sideroad 15 and 10 th Line.
	Detour Routes: Detour routes for vehicular traffic can be found on the Town’s website. Detour road signs will be in place prior to all temporary road closures.
	Open for Business: Local businesses will be open throughout construction. All are welcome! Businesses with any construction-related concerns are advised to contact the Town.
