4.1 Economic Development Department – Monthly Brief

4.2 Business Community Updates

4.2.1 *Film in Erin:* David reported that he has been approached by several property owners after presenting at the Mayor's Breakfast. He is investigating legalities and

safety procedures regarding film on public/private property to assist with answering questions. Two quotes for a photography project were supplied to the committee, with the primary focus being used on the Ontario Creates site. Discussion was held on maximum committee budget, ownership of the photography, the capacity of the Town/County to support film projects in the area and timing/locations of the photography. David will investigate and report back on these questions.

4.3 **EEDC Strategic Priorities**

4.3.1 Wastewater Construction Response: discussion was held on the online dashboard, current progress, and delays on start dates. We need to be mindful of the construction exhaustion concern that sets in with such a long construction period ahead of us. Committee members brainstormed ideas for campaigns. 'Open for Business' will be the umbrella for all activities but we need roughly 4 campaigns to help keep messaging fresh. Some opportunities included: prize passports, event presence including festivals in neighbouring communities, an app, visitor surveys, a calendar of events, and use of notice boards for those not on social media.

Strategic Planning: this is the current priority including a revised process. Business retention has been the top concern for our Town in the face of construction.
