WEST CREDIT RIVER MONITORING PROGRAM

Erin Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF)

Please be advised that the Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVC), acting on behalf of the Town of Erin, will launch a monitoring program along the West Credit River starting on Tuesday, August 29th, at three locations within 150m upstream and 700m downstream of the West Credit River crossing at Winston Churchill Blvd.

As a condition of the Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA) for the WRRF, this monitoring program is being initiated to help maintain the health and function of the West Credit River. The initial monitoring phase will be used to obtain river water quality and aquatic baseline data prior to commencing operation of the WRRF. The monitoring program is projected to span five years with the subsequent monitoring phase capturing river water quality and aquatic data during the operational period of the WRRF.

The ECA was issued by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) to the Town of Erin for the construction, operation and maintenance of the WRRF.

As part of this monitoring program, the CVC will conduct monthly manual sampling tasks and install two real-time monitoring stations. These monitoring stations will be strategically located at one upstream and one downstream along the West Credit River, in relation to the WRRF's treated effluent outfall site. This outfall discharge site will be situated in the West Credit River, just west of Winston Churchill Blvd.
