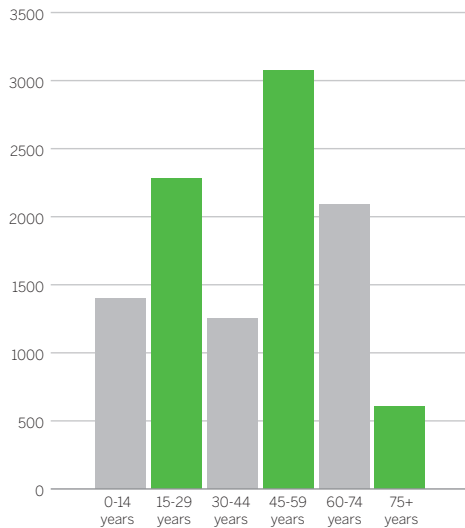
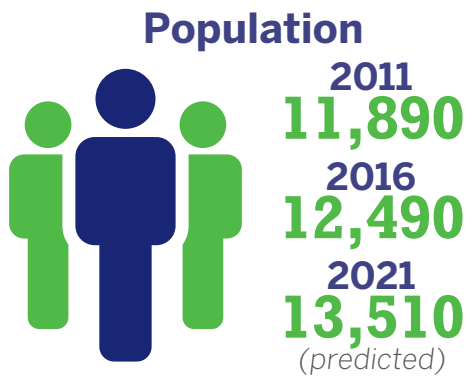

AGE DISTRIBUTION

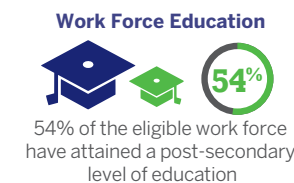
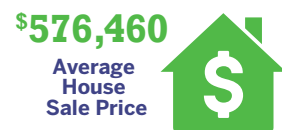
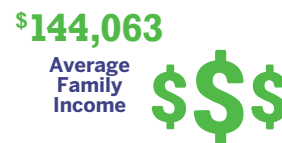
